The Government provides additional funding to schools for each Year 7 pupil who did not achieve the expected level (Level 4 or 100) in the Key Stage 2 national curriculum tests in reading and/or mathematics. The purpose of this funding is to enable schools to deliver additional support, such as individual tuition or intensive support in small groups, for those pupils that most need it.

Funding received by De La Salle is used to provide a programme of specific intervention for each of these pupils. The programme is overseen by a member of staff who runs the training for the LSAs and monitors the progress made by the pupils involved in the programme. Parents are also involved so that any additional support can be followed up at home.

Academic year: 2015/16

- Literacy catch-up 26 pupils were on the catch up programme in 2015/2016.
- Maths catch-up 17 pupils were on the catch up programme in 2015/2016.

Literacy outcomes:

- 97% made improvements over the year. * (1 pupil is continuing with the programme in 2016)
- 70% moved to Level 4 or above.

Maths outcomes:

- 100% made improvements over the year.
- 50% moved to Level 4 or above.

Follow up actions:

- Continue intervention for Yr8 Ma/ English follow on group.
- Assess and adjust delivery of Maths Catch-Up
