Dear Parent/Carer,

As the dust settles after the whirlwind that is Ofsted, I wanted to write to update you on several school issues.

## Ofsted

Unfortunately, until the report is published I am unable to share any of the judgements that were made by the team, however, I do want to thank you for your overwhelming support. You gave us a significant number of responses to the Parentview survey and the vast majority of these were positive. Please also be assured that, where these responses were less positive, we are looking to address the issues.

Though I will speak to students directly this week during their assemblies, I wanted to also let you know how impressed the inspectors were with our students. One of the inspectors described them as the biggest asset the school has. They were truly a credit to themselves and to you.

## **Parental Meetings**

In my previous letter, I said I would arrange a meeting with parents to introduce myself and update you on the progress being made at the school. ### **High Energy Drinks**

One area of concern raised by the inspectors was a small number of students who had energy drinks with them. To address this issue we will be carrying out a number of random searches of students over the coming weeks and any energy drinks found will be disposed of and not returned to students.
