

Subjects Everyone Takes GCSE subjects

- English
- maths
- R.E.
- Science (double award for vast majority)

Non-GCSE but statutory subjects

- PSHCE(including Citizenship & Careers)
- P.E.

G.C.S.E.s into the future....

They are still two-year courses but have received a lot of content from A-level and so De La Salle has extended Key Stage 4 to 3 years.

There is no longer coursework in most subjects.

All subjects are assessed by exams at the end of the course. There are typically two or three exams per subject.

Everyone chooses either history or geography or computing.

(A very small number will be invited to follow the ASDAN life-skills course in this option block.)
